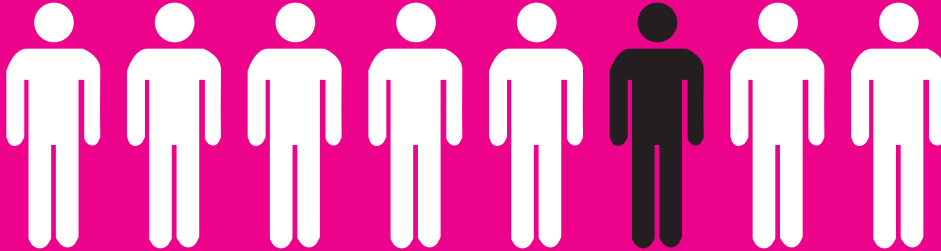

The scale of addiction in the UK means that nearly every workplace is affected by this illness in one way or another, and it is becoming central to the role of HR departments to manage addicted staff.

Despite the rapid growth of addiction within society, the skills required to support addicts along the road to recovery are comparatively rare.

Each year the UK loses 17 million working days to alcohol addiction alone, costing the economy £6.4 billion and HR departments find themselves on the front line of managing this crisis.

Often employers and colleagues become stressed, exhausted and defeated by the addictive behaviour and the only option becomes discipline and dismissal.

The Living Room Cardiff has developed a programme to train recovery coaches as skilled helpers who can support addicts to overcome their illness.

Our programme specifically meets the needs of HR specialists by giving them skills, approaches and insights into addiction.

The techniques, skills and knowledge is drawn from years of research, best practice and expertise from leaders in the field.

The three part module is taught in weekend workshops at the Living Room Cardiff, supported by expert tutors and online learning from the University of Wales Trinity St David.

The course is accredited through the university and counts as thirty credits towards a university degree.
